Public Works Report:

- Operations continuing.
  - Do to the heavier than normal operations with multiple/continual snowfalls, Additional maintenance was needed on all snow removal equipment and some parts are still outstanding as of this report.
  - Public Works is continuing to focus on mitigating snow in sections based on severity and use around Houston.
  - Public input: 6 written road comment/complaints and 71 called in road comment/complaints. All but a few that require road structure changes are resolved at this point.
