PASSED AND APPROVED by a duly constituted quorum of the Houston City Council, Alaska this 13 day of October 2015.

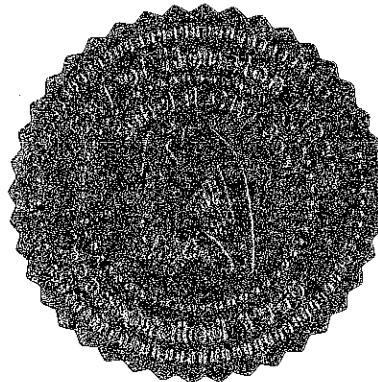
