### Public Works Report:

Road grading is being done to city roads.

Brush cutting is being done along city roads, cutting has been done in the following areas:

Kenlar rd., King Arthur, Rainee, Paydirt, Robin Hood, Prince John, Merlin, Round Table, No Name hill, Ballyshannon, Donnybrook, Airlo, Bryan, Brentwood.

PW has completed remodeling the old emergency services rooms at FS9-1 for the State Troopers to use as a substation.

Hand delivered notices to several residents of Cheri Lake Road regarding the ROW clearing to be done for the road upgrade. Six properties were found to have obstructions within the ROW easement of Cheri lake road to include Fences, septic systems and private utilities, residents were notified that all items in the ROW must be removed. MSB Clearing contractors will be on the project the 1<sup>st</sup> week of July to begin the clearing process.

Hobbit rd. and One Horse lane have been connected and the barricades removed, a new road surface has been built on One Horse lane bringing it up to minimum road standards that will permit PW equipment and emergency services to have full access.

Cities Excavator is now operational.

### Parks Report:

- Zero Lake Trailhead is open and has been active.
- Little Susitna camp ground opened on May 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Little Su day park is open and active.
- Planning underway for a walking trail from Day Park to millers landing by volunteers.
- Reviewing land on Susitna Ct, for possible river access point and boat launch.
